Summary of Results

Free school meals provide crucial support for low-income families by ensuring that children from impoverished backgrounds receive the required nutrition at no extra cost.

The analysis shows that around 4,500 (13%) of all Havering School pupils resident within Havering are receiving free school meals; this is less than both London (16%) and England (14%).

Exploration at Ward level shows that the more deprived wards such as Gooshays, Heaton and South Hornchurch house the greatest proportion of children receiving free school meals at 23%, 21% and 20% respectively; all three possess significantly more by proportion than Havering as a borough, London and England. Whereas the least deprived wards such as Upminster, Hacton and Emerson Park harbour the smallest proportions at 3%, 5% and 5% respectively, which are significantly less than Havering, London and England.


When looking at all school children resident in Havering that receive free school meals, the majority of them (47%) are resident within the North Locality being the most deprived, whilst Central and South Locality possess similar proportions at 24% and 28% respectively.



Figure 1: % School pupils receiving free school meals in Havering, London and England, January 2017




