Usual Resident Population by Sex and Age for Havering

Introduction

Understanding and planning for population change is one of the key factors in service planning for local authorities. This report is one of a series of reports in LG Inform based on a single collection; the aim is to provide users with quick and easy access to all the metrics contained in the collection and present this in a variety of charts, tables and maps.

This report provides an overview of the "Census 2021 rounded population and household estimates for local authorities in England and Wales, by sex and five-year age" as published by the Office for National Statistics, with a particular focus on Havering.

Figures relate to the usual resident population or household.

- A usual resident is anyone who on Census Day, 21 March 2021 was in the UK and had stayed or intended to stay in the UK for a period of 12 months or more, or had a permanent UK address and was outside the UK and intended to be outside the UK for less than 12 months.
- A household is:
 - one person living alone: or
 - a group of people (not necessarily related) living at the same address who share cooking facilities and share a living room or dining area
 - A household must have at least one usual resident at the address. A group of short-term residents living together or a group of visitors staying at an address is not classified as a household.

Executive summary

Havering is a London borough in the London region.


On Census Day, 21 March 2021, the size of the usual resident population in Havering was 262,000 people: this is an increase of 10% (24,768) since 2011, when it was 237,232 people. Havering is now ranked 19 (out of 33 London boroughs in the London region) in terms of total population.

Havering's population increase, at $\underline{10}$ %, compares to a $\underline{8}$ % increase for the London and a $\underline{7}$ % increase for England.

As of 2021, Havering is ranked 32 out of the 33 local authority areas in the London for population density, with around 23.32 persons per hectare of land. The population density for the London is 55.98 persons per hectare and for England it is 4.34 persons per hectare

Of the 262,000 people in Havering, $\underline{135,600}$ were women ($\underline{51.8}$ % of the population) and $\underline{126,400}$ men ($\underline{48.2}$ %). $\underline{18.9}$ percent ($\underline{49,400}$) are children aged under 15, $\underline{63.6}$ percent ($\underline{166,700}$) are adults aged 15 to 64 and $\underline{17.6}$ percent ($\underline{46,200}$) are aged 65 and over; $\underline{2.7}$ percent ($\underline{7,000}$) of the resident population are 85 and over.

Population by sex


Of the 262,000 people in Havering, $\underline{135,600}$ were women ($\underline{51.8}$ % of the population) and $\underline{126,400}$ men ($\underline{48.2}$ %). In 2011, $\underline{123,023}$ were women ($\underline{51.9}$ % of the population) and $\underline{114,209}$ men ($\underline{48.1}$ %).

In London, 51.5% of the population were women and 48.5% were men. In England, 51.0% of the population were women and 49.0% were men.

The female population of Havering has increased by $\underline{10}$ % and the male population has increased by $\underline{11}$ % from 2011.


In the London the female population has increased by $\underline{9}\%$ and the male population has increased by $\underline{6}\%$ from 2011.

Number of usual residents by sex (2011 and 2021) for Havering






Number of usual residents by sex (2021) for Havering compared to London and England



Percentage change in number of usual residents by sex (2011 and 2021) for Havering compared to London and England






Population by broad age group

Of the 262,000 people living in Havering on Census day, 18.9 percent (49,400) were children aged under 15, 63.6 percent (166,700) were adults aged 15 to 64 and 17.6 percent (46,200) were aged 65 and over; 2.7 percent (7,000) of the resident population were 85 and over.

This compares to 18.1 percent aged 0 to 14, 70.0 percent aged 15 to 64 and 11.9 percent aged 65 and over for the London region as a whole, and 17.4 percent aged 0 to 14, 64.2 percent aged 15 to 64 and 18.4 percent aged 65 and over for England.


Since 2011, Havering has seen a 20 percent increase in children aged under 15, a 8 percent increase in adults aged 15 to 64 and a 9 percent increase in those aged 65 and over.

Population - Three broad age groups (2021) for Havering






Usual resident population by broad age groups (2021) for Havering compared to London and England




Percentage change in number of usual resident population by broad age groups (2011 to 2021) for Havering compared to London and England




Population by five-year age bands


The largest age group in Havering was those aged 30 - 34 (19,300 people or 7.36%).

In the London the largest age group was those aged 30 - 34 (9.19%) and in the England the largest age group was those aged 30 - 34 (people or 7.00%).
