Impact of Change	According to the application: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Proposed core opening hours will not change and merged site will keep open on Saturdays;• Closing time on four weekdays will be one hour earlier;• There is no reduction in advanced and enhanced services offered;• Access to pharmaceutical services will not be affected;• The remaining site is within 5 minutes' walk from the site to be closed and there are 4 other community pharmacies within a mile;• Change to staffing levels is not known.
